Getting Started: Social Networking for Medical Libraries

Working in libraries, you've likely heard of Twitter, Facebook, Flickr, MySpace, FriendFeed, or another social networking website. But perhaps you don't know what all the fuss is about. How are these technologies relevant to medical libraries? What are some of their uses? And what about privacy and security, especially for hospital libraries?

This class will focus on the basics: getting started with Flickr (<http://www.flickr.com>), Facebook (<http://www.facebook.com>), and Twitter (<http://www.twitter.com>), some common uses in the library setting, and privacy/security features of each web site. Setting up a page for yourself or your library typically only takes a few minutes, and many privacy features exist.

Examples of medical libraries currently using these technologies will also be showcased. Come with any questions you may have!

Our instructor for this class will be Leigh Mhlrad, Systems and Technology Librarian for Albany Medical College. She has been using Facebook and Flickr since 2006, and recently began experimenting with Twitter.

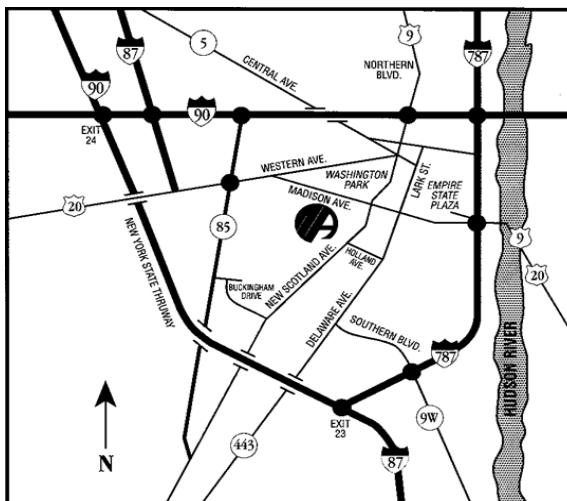


Hospital Library Service Program

Directions:

Take the Northway (I-87) to I-90 East. Exit at I-787 South (Albany). Exit at Madison Avenue. Proceed approximately one mile on Madison Avenue. Turn left onto New Scotland Avenue. Go two blocks. Albany Medical Center will be on your right. Parking is either on street or in the paid lots.

- Enter through the Neil Hellman College front entrance, then:
- Turn right and walk down the hall to the library.
 - Enter the library and turn left at the desk.
 - Take Elevators to the 5th Floor.
 - Go straight to 2nd door on right for the computer lab.
